Ice shows are a great way for our skaters to perform for the public, forge new friendships, and most importantly, have FUN! We hope everyone will choose to be a part of The Northeast Ice Skating Club’s annual ice show!

THE ADVANCED GROUP is open to all NEISC skaters who have contracted at least one Freestyle session during Sessions I, II or III in the 2018/19 skating year and who have completed the Basic Skills Program/Freeskate 6. (You will be grouped with other skaters working on a similar badge level.) You may join NEISC at any point in time before the show application deadline.

SOLOISTS: *Please see below for requirements!*

All soloists are required to participate in a group number.

Soloist programs should be no longer than their USFS test level requirement length.

Soloist music requests must be submitted and delivered to either NEISC mailbox for approval no later than March 16th (*more info & a music selection form will be sent out separately*).

Show committee has the right to refuse any inappropriate solo costumes or music choices.

The Advanced Group number *Non-Refundable* cost per skater is **\$195** or **\$225** if a solo, duet or step-out is applicable and includes:

- Skating outfit and tights
- All rehearsals directed by professional coaches and their choreography
- All ice for the group rehearsals, dress rehearsals and one nights of Ice Shows
 - Advertising and marketing of the Ice Show
 - Props, lighting and set design

DEADLINE and DEPOSIT for the advanced group and Solo/Duet/Step-out Skater is **Saturday, November 17th**

ATTENDANCE at all rehearsals is **MANDATORY**. If you have a conflict with a scheduled rehearsal date, you must contact Stacy Lane via email at northeastisc@yahoo.com in advance for approval.

Show Program/Ad Book Mandatory Requirements

The show program/ad book is an opportunity to generate additional funds to cover necessary show costs not met by skater show fees. Ad sales are a critical source of income allowing NEISC to run a successful show. **This year every skater is required to purchase and/or sell a minimum of one ad. Ads start at \$25. Skaters who have not sold an ad will be responsible for the minimum ad cost of \$25, which must be paid prior to dress rehearsal.** We encourage members to participate in selling additional corporate sponsorship ads. *REMEMBER*, this is a fundraising opportunity for the club that enables us to continue to keep costs down for our members. 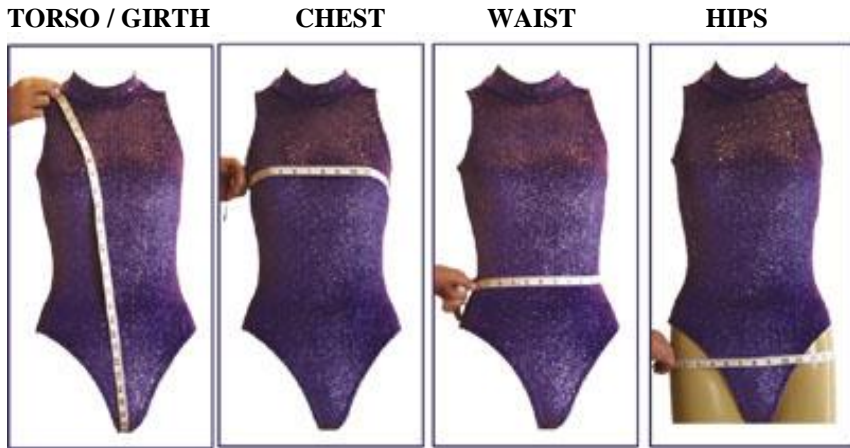

The Most Important Measurement is the "Girth" or Torso measurement. Place the measuring tape on the shoulder as shown, and drop the tape down the back of the body, between the legs and up the front. When the tape comes back to the starting point (see Photo), that is your Torso measurement.
