Ice shows are a great way for our skaters to perform for the public, forge new friendships, and most importantly, have FUN! We hope everyone will choose to be a part of The Northeast Ice Skating Club's annual ice show!

An important part of US Figure Skating's Badge curriculum is learning how to skate to music choreographed by a figure skating professional. It is a required element of the USFS Badge and Basic Skills Program. The benefits of your child skating in an ice show will fulfill this curriculum.

- **The Learn to Skate Program Group Numbers** are open to all NEISC skaters who have participated in one of our learn to skate / badge programs in either Sessions I, II, III or IV.
- The learn to skate level is for **skaters who are brand new / snow plow sam level and just learning how to skate (snowplow sam thru Badge / Basic 2 in the badge program)**. Skaters will be grouped with other skaters working on similar skills. All groups will be posted in advance and if you have any concern about your child's group, please speak with the show director as soon as possible.

**DEADLINE and DEPOSIT** for the Learn to Skate/Basic Skills Group application is:  
**SATURDAY, January 26<sup>th</sup>.**

The Badge/Basic Skills Group number *Non-Refundable* cost per skater is **\$95.00** applicable and includes:

- Skating outfit and tights
- All rehearsals directed by professional coaches and their choreography
- All ice for the group rehearsals, dress rehearsals and the Ice Show
- Advertising and marketing of the Ice Show
- Props, lighting and set design

**Show Program/Ad Book Mandatory Requirements**

The show program/ad book is an opportunity to generate additional funds to cover necessary show costs not met by skater show fees. Ad sales are a critical source of income allowing NEISC to run a successful show. **This year every skater is required to purchase and/or sell a minimum of one ad. Ads start at \$25. Skaters who have not sold an ad will be responsible for the minimum ad cost of \$25, which must be paid prior to dress rehearsal.** We encourage members to participate in selling additional corporate sponsorship ads. *REMEMBER*, this is a fundraising opportunity for the club that enables us to continue to keep costs down for our members. **The Most Important Measurement is the "Girth" or Torso measurement.** Place the measuring tape on the shoulder as shown, and drop the tape down the back of the body, between the legs and up the front. When the tape comes back to the starting point (see Photo), that is your Torso measurement.
